- A minimum of 60 hours from a four-year school.
- A minimum of 30 hours from FHSU.

Notes

- A maximum of 30 hours can be earned by credit by exam (DANTES, CLEP etc.)
- Community college hours, credit by exam and lower division ACE approved military credit cannot total over 64 hours.
- JROTC courses will count as free electives and may count in some degrees as Area of Concentration credits. *Educational Psychology* can count as 3 of the 12 Social and Behavioral credits when not used in an Area of Concentration.
