

## Resource Assistance:

(Expired/now out of date) **Text books w/DVDs** for **JROTC DOD directed courses** were originally provided to each (Navy, Air Force and Army only) JROTC Detachment by their Service Directorate. These textbooks are no longer required. For ALL Non-Army Instructors, JROTC spouses, family members, and colleagues within local high schools; replacement, 100 % on-line, up-to-date pedagogy/text material is now provided on the left sidebar of this link: <https://www.leadershipcredit.info/dod-jrotc-certification/> for each course. There is no textbook fee for this support.

The current **tuition** for this degree at Fort Hays State University is **\$895.55** per 3 credit course, or approximately **\$9,255.05** for the MLS Degree, or **\$10,747.80** for the MSE Degree; fully paid by your *GI Bill* or *VA VOCReHab* as eligible! Semester Graduate Course Stipend Rates are as follows:

**Fall & Spring Semesters:**

6 credits receive 75% of a full stipend, 9+ credits receive 100% (full) stipends

**Summer Sessions:**

3 credits receive 75% of a full stipend, 6+ credits receive 100% (full) stipends

\*Individuals qualifying for Chapter 30 and retiring after 2004 could also be eligible for an additional 12 months of Chapter 33 monies. Check with the VA for your individual situation by calling **1-888-442-4551** and speak to a VA Counselor on where you stand.

These 100% on-line academic programs are achievable in a low stress 18 – 24 calendar month cycle, using about 14 – 18 months of your available **[GI Bill benefits](#)**.

Additional funding could also be available in your local school districts or through PTA Scholarships where provided.
